GENERAL INFORMATION

1. INTRODUCTION

The ASEAN-Japan Cybersecurity Capacity Building Centre (AJCCBC) in partnership with the Swiss Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (FDFA) through Forum of Incident Response and Security Teams (FIRST) has prepared a Capture-the-Flag (CTF) competition for the students and cybersecurity enthusiasts under the age of twenty-six from the ASEAN Member States to encourage engagement in cybersecurity and provide opportunity in practicing CTF.

The FIRST CTF Challenge is a series of technical problems designed to provide a fun opportunity to utilize creative technical problem-solving abilities to solve incident response inspired challenges. The CTF consists of a series of technical exercises (challenges) where the participants must find an answer or flag and submit it to the CTF platform. Every flag submitted contributes to their score. Everyone will be competing against other participants from the two countries individually.

The categories of challenges may include Network, Cryptography, Reverse Engineering, Programming, Miscellaneous, and Puzzle and others.

The top ten high scoring individuals will be granted a certificate from the AJCCBC.

3. TARGET

Students/Cybersecurity enthusiasts under Twenty-Six (26) of age as of 1st July 2024 from the ASEAN Member States.

4. PREREQUISITE

Basic technical background in incident response and/or cybersecurity required

5. PARTICIPATION

The attendees will participate in the activity **individually, not as a team.**

6. VENUE

Virtual Platform (Zoom). The access links will be provided after registration.

7. EQUIPMENT PREPARATION

- A laptop or PC with stable internet connection.
- Preinstalled Zoom and Mattermost.
